## Step 1 - Getting Started



Contact us through Facebook, text message, face to face or email



A Thriving Futures team member will talk to you about the Program and get to know you!



After having a chat, we will guide you through the basic "about you" info



Then, we'll help you get together everything you need to start - we're talking ID, proof of Covid-vaccination, and working with children check!

## Step 2- The Academy

Our mentors work with you to tailor your individual learning pathway based on your interests and skillset



There are many flexible learning options you can choose, including blended 'fast track options. For example:



- attend Early Years workshops
- complete some or all of the online learning component (12 modules)
- gain experience working in an Early Learning Centre or Outside School Hours setting



You will be supported by mentors all the way through your journey!

## Step 3- your future!

When do you graduate? Once you have:

-been actively engaged in learning OR

been employed in an Early Learning Centre or Outside School Hours setting OR

commenced accredited training (Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care)



We then help prep you for an interview! Once offered a job through be the Thriving Futures program, we make sure you have ongoing mentoring and support.



What's the next step? We can also support you through further study (Cert III or diploma here we come!) through our scholarship program.
